## About Auroville Institute of Applied Technology/AIAT

- AIAT was founded in 2004 with financial aid from the German Government and numerous private donors. Its purpose is to empower rural youth with skills to earn a dignity livelihood. It operates as a non-profit unit of the Auroville Foundation (more information available at [aiat.in](http://aiat.in)).
- AIAT, situated in one of the most backward areas of Tamil Nadu, serves a diverse group of youth from the bottom of the social and economic pyramid. 95% of our trainees depend on the availability of a stipend (BPL), with 40% belonging to the scheduled caste. This diversity is a testament to our commitment to inclusivity and social impact.
- AIAT adopts a holistic pedagogical approach that addresses the concerns of both stakeholders—the trainees and the companies involved.
- Since 2022, AIAT has been affiliated with Pondicherry University as a college of Applied Sciences offering three-year Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc) degree courses in Electric and Electronic Technologies, Information Technology and Cyber Security, Software Development and Machine Learning, Mechatronics and Production Technology, and Applied Electronics and Chip Design.
- AIAT, in its commitment to providing practical and relevant training, also provides Central Government-recognized 1-2-year industrial training programs under a dual system of training. This is made possible through our collaboration with ten regional companies, ensuring that our trainees are equipped with the industry's required skills.

Today, in the middle of June 24, we would like to keep our promise to you, the parents and students: to have **our school bus** by July 2024 at the latest. Here it is:



The bus is five years old, from a school for children with special needs that was closed, is in good condition, has travelled 71.000 km, has 26 seats, and we paid 12 Lakhs (approx. \$14.380) for it. Including taxes, registrations for Pondicherry and Villupuram, MOT test, power steering installation and transfer to AIAT, it costs around 14 Lakhs (a new one would have cost 22 Lakhs). As we said, having a college school bus is very important in this country. Depending on how you look at it, we can now show another basic in the search for new students, and we have made a small leap in quality. *THANK YOU once again for your great help!*



On the keyword **'Admission'**: We started marketing for the new academic year in May. The admission of new students is mainly done through the government's central CENTAC portal in Pondicherry. Registration for admission to B.Voc. courses has started at CENTAC. By the end of August, we will know how many students enrol for the following B.Voc. courses in Software Development & Machine Learning, Information Technology, Electric and Electronic Technology (Sustainability & Renewable Energy), Mechatronics and Production Technology, Applied Electronics and Chip Design. We are hopeful of improving the intake in B.Voc. courses.

In the current academic year, eight students (4 girls and four boys) out of fifteen



B.Voc. in Software Development & Machine Learning are receiving a scholarship (thanks to your support—and brand new—thanks to 'Reaching for the Stars' and help from the BFL Foundation in Bangalore). We hope for further scholarship donations. In most cases, it depends on whether students enrol.

By mid-May, 12 students from the Software Development & Machine Learning class 2023 had passed their semester exams. All but one student did well. Even students with special needs pass practical exams in physics and software. The examiners from Pondicherry University were full of praise for the student's knowledge and practical and communication skills. They were said to be more advanced than the students at the university and its affiliated colleges. Of course, we are pleased about that.

The above course in Software Development & Machine Learning is currently held at three locations in Auroville, so we are moving back and forth. AIAT should gradually hold all Bachelor courses in Aurobrindavan/Palmyra so that suitable classrooms and workshops, seminar rooms, a principal office, Staffrooms, a library, and the college's administration are at one location. We are, therefore, increasingly working on fundraising applications for potential donors inside and outside India, and we hope for your loyal support.

In the Winter 2023 Annual Report, we announced that **Lavkamad** would be stepping down further in April, as Manish will now take over most of his duties. Nothing came of this. Manish went back to northern India with his family. Lavkamad spent nine weeks on holiday in Germany - a senior teacher stood in for him as best she could - and has been 'back on post'\* in Auroville at +/- 36° since May (\*phrase from the German Consulate, Chennai). But the possible inclusion of AIAT in SAIER, the Education Board of Auroville, which was also announced to you, is going well. That would be a relief for Lavkamad. As you know, he has been doing his best for a long time. Like this, for example:

Collaboration with Min Vayu, IIT-Bombay, and AIAT in the field of sustainability: Lavkamad, Director of AIAT, Prof. Dr. Parag Bharagava, Chair of Materials Science at IIT-Bombay, and Jorge Ayrza, an Aurovilian from Ecuador and Executive of Min Vayu, have been working in the field of sustainability for years. They talked about a possible collaboration in renewable energy and cyclical economy. MinVayu is interested in collaborating with AIAT in teaching and research, and IIT-Bombay is interested in collaborating with MinVayu.

Farewell to Simon Hanl, a volunteer from Austria. Simon Hanl's time as a volunteer at AIAT (we introduced him in last year's annual report) ended with a small farewell ceremony and these words: "It was a pleasure to be here. I felt very welcome and gained many new experiences and insights." We wish him all the best in his studies

in Vienna and his future career, and we thank him very much for enriching AIAT with his knowledge and commitment.
